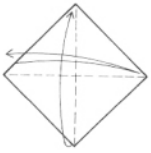
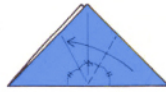

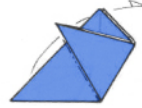


TO START

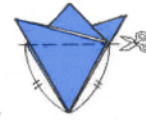
i Fold paper in half (corner to corner) in both directions, unfold.



ii Take right corner and fold in towards the middle of the left edge.



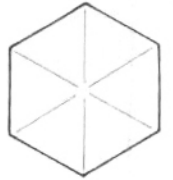
iii Pull left corner to opposite side of right and match up folds. The paper should be symmetrical.



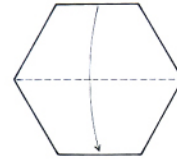
iv Clip the top from point to point to create an equilateral triangle.



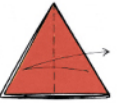
v Open.



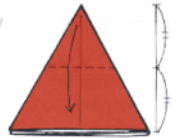

Fold leftmost crease, and follow by folding the first diagonal crease at bottom left base, squashing the first fold back in to make a hexagon corner.

Keep folding & squashing counter-clockwise at inner hexagon crease line until a smaller hexagon of equilateral triangles is created.

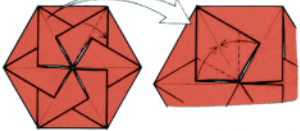
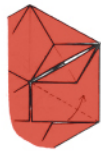

Repeat steps 7 - 9 on each arm to complete your **SNOWFLAKE**

Unfold wings, refold inverted into the larger fold to create a center line. Take center flap and pull back to hexagon corner.

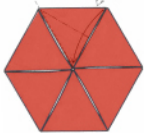
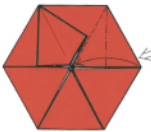

Fold one arm in half, then fold each corner to be flush with new center line.

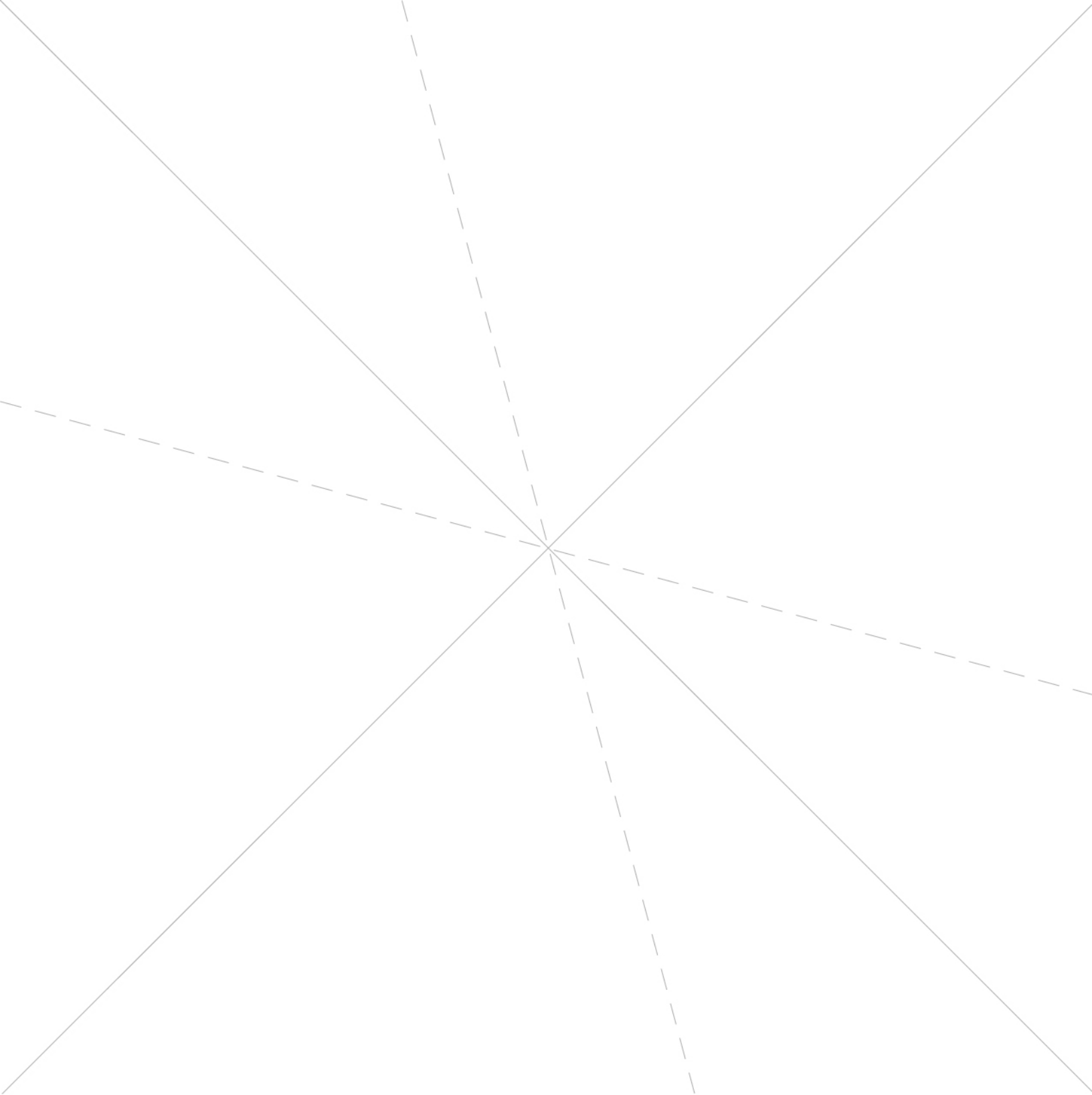
Lift one triangle, open fold and squash in half. Repeat on all triangles.

For the 6th triangle fold, be sure to pull out the extra paper from under the first folded triangle to be able to make the last squash.
